

# UNIFIED PRIVACY POLICIES OF ALL PLATFORMS

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

In EMET BUSINESS GROUP we respect and protect the privacy of the visitors of our websites and of the clients that use our services. To ensure transparency, this Privacy Policy describes our information management practices when accessing content that we own or that we operate on the XVFIVE, CASH2P, CASH2PR, DIN-DOM, SHO Xen, AILEWUX and FASWET websites, or any other website, page, feature or content of our property or that we operate (collectively, the "WEBSITES" or "PLATFORMS") or when using the mobile applications of any of the mentioned platforms, any API of the aforementioned platforms or third party applications that they use API and related services (collectively referred to as "SERVICES" in the following).

To access any of our Sites, it is not necessary to provide any information. However, to make requests for information, or to request a specific service, it is necessary for the user to provide data in the existing forms in the respective website for the purposes described above. All fields are mandatory except those that are specifically designated as optional. If not covered, the consequence is the impossibility of providing the service that is intended to be contracted or the impossibility of sending the request for information.

**We reserve the right to modify this Privacy Policy at any time and, when required by applicable laws and competent authorities; We will notify you of the changes made to this Privacy Policy. If we make substantial changes, we will notify you by email (sent to the email address specified in your account) or by a notice in our Services before the change becomes effective.**

## Information that is collected

We collect the following types of information:

I) Personal identification information: full name, date of birth, age, nationality, gender, signature, utility bills, photographs, telephone numbers, home address or email.

II) Formal identification information: tax identification number, passport number, driver's license data, national identity document data, photo identification cards or visa information.

III) Financial information: bank account information, primary account number (PAN) of the payment card (when applicable), transaction history, commercial data or tax identification.

IV) Transaction information: information about the transactions you make with our Services, such as the name of the beneficiary, your name, the amount or the time stamp.

V) Work information: location of the office, position or description of the function.

VI) Internet Identifiers: data on tracking / geolocation, browser fingerprint, OS, name and version of the browser or personal IP addresses.

VII) Usage data: responses to surveys, information provided to our assistance team, publications in public social networks, authentication data, security questions, user identification, clickstream data and other data collected through cookies and similar technologies.

In addition to any **additional information** necessary to provide any service or information requested by the USER

## Purpose of the data

Our WEBSITES collect certain personal data that are entered by the USER freely in a form with the purpose of being able to contract or make use of the different services, as well as answer and identify the requests made by the USER. Our platforms will inform you that they will automatically manage this data for the administration, expansion and improvement of their services, as well as for technical and commercial purposes on the products and services offered by EMET BUSINESS GROUP, understanding as such the company holding the service specifically requested by the user, the other services provided by such company, and the controllers, subsidiaries or commercially linked to it. Likewise, the WEB SITES collect certain data in the area of human resources and that of distributors and affiliates in order to proceed with the selection of future workers and distributors of the company and maintain contact with them. Likewise, the WEB SITES collect certain basic data from sources accessible to the public in order to perform commercial tasks on the services provided by the WEBSITES.

We recommend keeping in mind that when you have contracted with us or our platforms, we can use the information collected to:

I) Evaluate your behavior in the banking system and your capacity and payment behavior.

II) Decide whether to grant you the product (s) and / or service (s) you request, or provide other Platform users with sufficient information to decide on the products and / or services that they will provide or contract with you.

III) Offer you products and / or own services and / or third parties, linked to the PLATFORMS or not (for example, accounts, loans, among others), which we can also do through third parties.

IV) Send you commercial offers, advertising and information in general of the products and / or services of the PLATFORMS and / or of third parties linked or not, (for example, with companies with which we have associations

or commercial alliances),

V) Use and / or transfer this information (inside or outside the country) to third parties linked or not to the PLATFORMS, national or foreign, public or private (for example: other PLATFORMS, printers, courier companies, auditing, among others).

VI) Send you invitations and surveys.

Our PLATFORMS access the contact lists of mobile devices used by users to provide their services. That information will be used only to locate and indicate cell phone numbers and / or emails of other users. In turn, users are authorized to share this information with our PLATFORMS.

## How your personal information is used

Our main purpose when we collect personal information is to provide a safe, fluid, efficient and personalized experience. In general, we use personal information to create, develop, operate, offer and improve our SERVICES, content and advertising and for the purpose of preventing data loss and fraud. We can use this information as follows:

- To respect compliance with legislation and regulations:

Some of our Central Services are governed by laws and regulations that require us to collect and use, in certain ways, your personally identifiable information, formal identification information, financial information, transaction information, employment information, online identifiers or usage data. . For example, our PLATFORMS must identify and verify customers who use our SERVICES to comply with laws for the prevention of money laundering and terrorist financing in all jurisdictions. In addition, we use third-party services to verify your identity by comparing the personal information you have provided to us with public records and third-party databases. When you increase the usual limits of buying and selling digital currency related to your PLATFORM account (s), understood as the average that is valued by the company according to the profile of the user, the jurisdiction in which it is located, and other factors of a similar nature, we may require you to provide additional information that we may use in collaboration with service providers acting on our behalf to verify your identity, address or other information provided by the User, or to manage the risk as required by current legislation.

- To enforce the terms of our user agreement and other agreements:

Our PLATFORMS manage very confidential information, such as your identification and financial data, so it is very important for us and our clients that we monitor, investigate, actively prevent and mitigate any activity that may be prohibited or illegal, enforce our agreements with third parties, and avoid infractions of our user agreements or agreements for other published SERVICES. In addition, we may charge commissions in accordance with your use

of our SERVICES. We collect information about the use of your account and we monitor in detail your interactions with our SERVICES. We may use any personal information collected in our SERVICES for these purposes.

- To provide the services of the WEBSITES:

For example, when you want to buy a digital currency, we demand certain information, such as your identification, contact information and payment information.

- To send communications about the Services:

We send you administrative or account-related information to keep you informed about our Services, updates or relevant security issues or provide information related to transactions. Without such communications, you may not be aware of important developments related to your account that may affect how you can use our Services.

- To provide services to the client:

We treat your personal information when you contact us to resolve issues, questions or disputes, charge commissions or solve problems. We may treat your information in response to another customer's request, as appropriate.

- To guarantee quality control:

We treat your personal information to do quality control and train staff to ensure that we provide accurate information. If we do not process personal information for quality control purposes, you may experience problems with the SERVICES, such as inaccurate transaction records or other interruptions. The basis of such treatment is the need to comply with our contractual obligations to you.

- To guarantee the security of the network and information

We treat your personal information to improve security, monitor and verify the identity or access to the service, combat spam or other malware or security risks and comply with the legislation of the relevant jurisdiction over current security. The situation regarding threats on the Internet is constantly evolving, so it is more important than ever that we have accurate and updated information about your use of our SERVICES

- For research and development purposes

We treat your personal information to better understand how you use the SERVICES on the WEBSITES and interact with them. In addition, we use such information to personalize, measure and improve the SERVICES of the PLATFORMS and the content and design of our WEBSITES and applications and to develop new services.

- To improve the website experience

We treat your personal information to provide a personalized experience and implement the preferences you request. For example, you may choose to give us access to certain personal information stored by third parties.

- To facilitate corporate acquisitions, mergers or transactions

We may treat any information about your account and use our SERVICES as necessary in the context of acquisitions, mergers or other corporate transactions. You have the option to close your account (s) if you do not want your personal information treated for those purposes.

- To participate in marketing activities

In accordance with your communication preferences, we may send you marketing communications to inform you of our partner events or events; to send segmented marketing, and to provide you with promotional offers according to your communication preferences. We use information about your use of our SERVICES and your contact information to provide you marketing communications. You may choose to stop receiving marketing communications at any time (this does not imply that we will stop treating your information for the purpose detailed in this clause).

We will not use your personal information without your permission for purposes other than those we have disclosed to you in this clause or in this Privacy Policy. Occasionally, we may request your permission to allow us to share your personal information with third parties (as long as it is necessary and / or required by the corresponding jurisdiction or indispensable for the provision of a Service). You may choose to refuse to share your personal information with third parties or to allow us to use your personal information for purposes that are incompatible with those for which we originally collected or subsequently obtained your authorization. If you choose to limit the use of your personal information in this way, certain features or SERVICES of our PLATFORMS may not be available to you. The consequences of not treating your personal information for such purposes is to terminate your account (s), since we can not provide the SERVICES in accordance with legal and regulatory requirements and with our quality standards.

## **How we protect and store personal information**

We understand how important your privacy is and that is why our PLATFORMS take (and require their service providers to take) physical, technical and administrative preventive measures to protect the security and confidentiality of the personal information you entrust to us.

We may store and process all of your personal and transactional information or part of it (including certain

payment information, such as encrypted bank routing or account numbers) in the various countries in which we operate around the world where our facilities are located or service providers as well. We protect your personal information with physical, electronic and procedural preventive measures in compliance with current legislation and regulations.

For example, we take computer preventive measures, such as firewalls and data encryption, implement physical access controls to our buildings and files and authorize access to personal information only to those employees who need it to fulfill their work responsibilities. A payment provider transfers the complete data of the credit cards and houses them externally in a secure manner in compliance with the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standards (PCI DSS).

**However, we can not guarantee that there will be no losses, misuse, unauthorized purchases or alterations of your data. Keep in mind that you have a vital role in protecting your own personal information. When registering on our PLATFORMS, it is important that you choose a password of sufficient length and complexity, that you do not reveal this password to third parties and that you notify us immediately if you become aware of any unauthorized access or use of your account. None of our PLATFORMS will be responsible for the incidents that may arise around personal data when these derive: either from an attack or unauthorized access to the systems in such a way that it is impossible to detect or prevent it even adopting the necessary measures according to the state of the current technology, or of a lack of diligence of the USER in terms of the guard and custody of their passwords and personal data.**

In addition, we can not ensure or guarantee the security or confidentiality of the information you transmit to us or that you receive from us via the Internet or wireless connection, including email, telephone or SMS, as we do not have the means to protect such information. Once it is sent or until we receive it. If you have reason to believe that your data is no longer secure, please contact us by writing to the email address or the corresponding physical address found in this Privacy Policy. All platforms have, as an additional guarantee, an SSL security certificate to guarantee the transmission of personal data under a secure area

**Specific consent of users in SINGAPORE or any other jurisdiction that recognizes the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) or has special regulations on user protection.**

If you are in Singapore or are a resident of that country or anyone that is regulated by the GDPR, you give your consent in a specific and voluntary way for the transfer of your personal information to our entity and its affiliates (matrices, subsidiaries and / or controllers), and service providers in the various countries in which we have presence, for the specific purposes of conducting an identity verification or verification, in order to prevent fraud and comply with our legal obligations.

It is possible that our PLATFORMS do not implement protections for personal data as exhaustive as those of the

countries in question. However, we require our service providers to treat your personal information in a strictly confidential manner and implement the appropriate security measures to protect it. In addition, we require you to comply with all of our other obligations under this Privacy Policy.

You may revoke your consent to this section at any time; to do so, you must follow the instructions in the clause **“Rights of access, rectification, cancellation, opposition and revoke consent”** with the subject **“Revoke data consent from Singapore or any other jurisdiction that recognizes the General Data Protection Regulations (General Data Protection Regulation GDPR) or have special regulations on user protection”**.

## How you can access or change your personal information

You have the right to review, correct or amend your personal information or delete that information when it is inaccurate. You can do it at any time; To do this, log in to your account and go to the corresponding Settings / Settings menu and select the option corresponding to your Profile.

If you close your Account (s) in any of our PLATFORMS, we will mark your account (s) in our databases as **“Closed”**, but we will keep your account information in our databases for the period described. in the clause **“Time by which we will treat your data”**. This is necessary to prevent fraud, since it is guaranteed that people who try to commit fraud can not avoid detection only by closing their account and opening a new account. However, if you close your account, we will not use your personal information for any other purpose, nor will it be sold to or shared with third parties, except to the extent necessary to prevent fraud and assist the authorities in enforcing compliance of the corresponding jurisdiction, as required by the corresponding legislation or in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

## Information from third-party sources

Occasionally, we may obtain information about you from third-party sources as required or permitted by current legislation, such as public databases, credit bureaus, identification verification partners, channel resellers and partners, marketing partners, and media social platforms.

- Public databases, credit bureaus and identification verification partners:

We obtain information about you from public databases and identification verification partners for the purposes of verifying your identity. Identification verification partners use a combination of government records and publicly available or properly licensed information about you to verify your identity. This information includes your name, address, job function, public work profile, credit history, condition with respect to any list of sanctions maintained by public authorities and other relevant data. We obtain this information to comply with our legal obligations, such as the laws for the prevention of money laundering. In some cases, we may process additional information about you to ensure that our SERVICES are not used fraudulently or for other illicit activities. In such cases, the treatment

is necessary for us to continue to comply with our contract with you and third parties.

## **Collection and use of information collected automatically**

We receive and store certain types of information automatically, for example, every time you interact with the WEBSITES or use the SERVERS. This information does not necessarily reveal your identity directly, but may include information about the specific device you use, such as the hardware model, the device ID, the operating system version, the web browser software (such as Firefox, Safari or Internet Explorer) and your device identifier/MAC address/Internet Protocol address (IP).

For example, we automatically receive and record information in our browser's server logs, which includes how you came to the Services and used them; your IP address; the type of device and the unique identification numbers of the devices; Device event information (such as locks, system activity and hardware configuration, browser type, browser language, date and time of your request and referring URL), general geographic location (ie, country or city) and other technical data collected through cookies, pixel tags and other similar technologies that uniquely identify your browser. We may also collect information about how your device interacted with our website, including the pages you accessed and the links you clicked on. We may use identifiers to recognize you when you arrive at any of the WEBSITES through an external link, for example, a link that appears on a third party's site.

## **Why we share personal information with third parties**

We take the precaution of allowing only those who need it to access their personal information to carry out their tasks and obligations and to share it with third parties who have the legitimate purpose of accessing it. We will only share your information in the following circumstances:

- We share your information with identification verification services to prevent fraud. This allows PLATFORMS to confirm your identity by comparing the information you provide us with public records and other third-party databases. These services may generate secondary data according to your personal information that can be used exclusively in relation to the provision of fraud prevention services and identity verification.
- We may share information with contract service providers that help us with part of our business operations, such as technology, marketing and billing services. Our contracts require these service providers to only use your information in connection with these services they provide to us.
- We share your information with financial institutions with which we partner to process the payments you have authorized.
- We may share your information with companies or other entities with which we plan to merge or acquire. In the event that such unification occurs, we will require that the new unified entity follow this Privacy Policy with respect to your personal information. You will receive prior notice of any changes in the current policies (whenever

necessary and / or required by the law of the corresponding jurisdiction).

- It is possible that your information is shared by court order in any of the jurisdictions in which we have presence.
- We may share your information with law enforcement bodies, officials or other third parties when we are forced by a subpoena, court or administrative order, or similar legal process or when we believe in good faith that the disclosure of personal information it is necessary to avoid physical damages or financial losses, to report alleged illegal activities or to investigate infractions of any other current policy of our PLATFORMS.

Any information that you enter in our WEBSITES or applications (and not directly in our PLATFORMS) will be shared with the owner of the website or the third party application. Your privacy policies will govern the use of your information.

## **How personal information is shared with third-party sites and services**

If you use your PLATFORM account (s) to transfer a digital currency in connection with the purchase or sale of goods or services, we or you may also provide the seller with your shipping address, name or email to help you. To complete your transaction with the seller. The seller is not authorized to use this information to market your services, unless you have accepted it. If an error occurred while making a digital currency transfer to the seller or is subsequently invalidated, we may provide the seller with the details of the incorrect transfer. To facilitate the resolution of disputes, we may provide the buyer with the address of the seller, so that the goods can be returned to the seller.

In connection with the transfer of digital currency between you and a third party, including merchants, a third party may share information about you with us, such as the email address or the mobile phone number that can be used to inform you that you have sent a transfer to a third party or he has received it. We may use this information in connection with such transfers to confirm that you are a client of our WEBSITES, that digital currency transfers have been enabled or to notify you that you have received digital currency. If you request that we validate your status as a client of our WEBSITES before a third party, we will access it. You can also choose to send or receive digital currency with an email address. In such cases, your username will appear in the email message by which your action is notified to the user of the designated email address.

Keep in mind that the merchants with whom you interact may have their own privacy policies and our PLATFORMS are not responsible for their operations, including, among others, their information practices. Information collected by third parties, which may include information such as contact details or location data, is governed by their own privacy practices. We recommend that you inform yourself about the privacy practices of these third parties.

If you authorize one or more third party applications to access your account (s) of our WEBSITES, then the information you have provided to the WEBSITES may be shared with those third parties. Unless, in turn, you give your authorization to said third parties, they are not allowed to use this information for purposes other than

facilitating your transactions using the SERVICES of our PLATFORMS.

## **Order of competent authorities - Legal Requirements**

Our PLATFORMS cooperate with the authorities of the competent jurisdictions and with other third parties to guarantee compliance with the laws, for example, on the protection of industrial and intellectual property rights, fraud prevention and other matters.

The PLATFORMS may reveal the Personal Information of its users upon request of the judicial or governmental authorities of the competent jurisdictions for the purposes of investigations conducted by them, even if there is no order or an executive or judicial summons, or for example (and without limitation to this assumption) when dealing with criminal or fraud investigations or those related to hacking or violation of copyright. In such situations, our PLATFORMS will collaborate with the competent authorities in order to safeguard the integrity and security of the Community and that of its users.

The PLATFORMS can (and users expressly authorize it) communicate any Personal Information about their users in order to comply with the regulations of the applicable jurisdiction and cooperate with the competent authorities to the extent that we understand it necessary and appropriate in relation to any investigation of an illicit or fraud, infringement of industrial or intellectual property rights, or any other activity that is illegal or that may expose our PLATFORMS or its users to any legal liability.

In addition, WEBSITES reserve the right (and expressly authorize us to do so) to communicate information about its users to other users, entities or third parties when there are sufficient reasons to consider that the activity of a user is suspected of attempting or committing a crime or try to harm other people. This right shall be used by the PLATFORMS at its discretion when they deem it appropriate or necessary to maintain the integrity and security of the Community and its USERS, to enforce the General Terms and Conditions and other Site Policies and to cooperate. with the enforcement and enforcement of the law of the competent jurisdiction. This right will be exercised by us independently that there is no judicial or administrative order to that effect.

## **Data transfer**

The USER by accepting these conditions accepts that their data may be transferred to companies with the same social composition (same shareholders) as the PLATFORMS, or subsidiary or controlled companies or commercial allies of EMET BUSINESS GROUP, these data will in any case be processed for the same purposes as for the PLATFORMS or for products and services that the USER has requested and necessarily imply the transfer of these data. Likewise, the data may be transferred in the development of marketing activities in the terms contained in these Policies. The PLATFORMS inform the USER that by adhering to these general conditions, he / she consents to the necessary and essential communication of his / her data to manage the services that he / she has contracted, communication linked to the same purpose for which the data were entered and, for both, related to the free

and legitimate acceptance of the legal relationship between the USER and the PLATFORMS, whose development, compliance and control implies the necessary communication of these data. In no case the PLATFORMS carry out actions, deals or will be responsible for the personal data of third parties that the user lodges in any of the services contracted. In relation to these personal data that the user can host is he who must have its own data protection policy, its files and, in general, comply with the laws in force and regulations that develop them.

## **Rights of access, rectification, cancellation, opposition and revoke consent.**

## **Cookies**

Our platforms use cookies to obtain information and perform statistical analysis on the use of websites -which can always be consulted and used anonymously- and to allow the operation of some services. The cookies we use are anonymous and do not refer to the personal data of the USER nor can they be accessed through them in any case to the data that the USER may have on his hard drive. The identity of the USER is never inserted directly into the cookie and therefore is not interceptable. The only non-anonymous cookies, that is to say, that allow identification, can only be assigned with the prior authorization of the USER when you want to have immediate identification to access restricted areas of the website without the USER manually inserting their passwords. In any case, if the USER wishes that these cookies are not installed, he has the possibility to configure his browser to prevent it without any alteration or modification in the use of our websites.

## **Accuracy of the data**

The USER is responsible for the veracity of their data, pledging not to introduce false data and to proceed to rectify them if necessary. Our PLATFORMS make available to the USER all the means for you to proceed with the modification of your data. It is allowed to make this modification from the unique private and secure area that the USER has in each website and to which he accesses through the keys obtained with the user registration; hence, the USER must be especially diligent in the guard and custody of these keys. The USER states that when he does not enter his personal data but those of a third party, he is authorized by him to introduce it.

## Spamming or unsolicited mailing

Our position on all our platforms is absolutely contrary to the practice of spamming and we never perform this type of behavior - we only send information to the emails provided by those who have registered as users on our websites and, therefore, accepted the present General Conditions and its data protection policy for the sending of this information or, as the case may be, to those persons who, previous telephone contact, have authorized the sending of such emails. Nor will we allow the use of these practices by the USER, proceeding to the withdrawal of services that may have contracted with our platforms and reserving the legal actions that are relevant.

## In charge of the treatment

## Under age

We do not knowingly request the collection of personal information from persons under 18 years of age. If it is

suspected that a user who sends personal information is under 18 years of age, the WEBSITES will take responsibility for their actions to their parents or legal guardians. In the event that the minor's parents or legal guardians do not agree to give consent on behalf of the minor, they must express it in writing to the corresponding platform's email and the latter will proceed to take the necessary measures to eliminate the information as soon as possible. It will always be an obligation of the parents or legal guardian of the minor to prove their quality as such.

## **Time by which we will treat your data**

The treatment will be given indefinitely, but remember that you can, at any time, revoke the consent as indicated in the clause **"Rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition"**.

## **How we use special permissions in android / ios mobile applications**

Access to the CAMERA: Unique and exclusive for reading QR codes, capture of documents to verify the authenticity of the user's information, only with the action required by the user.

Access to RECORD\_AUDIO: for some members we have a direct call to the service, only with the action required by the user.

Access to READ\_PHONE\_STATE: to prevent fraud, it is used for certain authentication / validation, so we record the origin and information of the mobile device.

Access to GET\_ACCOUNTS: to prevent fraud, it is used for authentication / validation of some transactions with other information on the mobile device.

Access to READ\_CONTACTS: allows you to choose contacts registered in the device to send SMS / email to request or request some operations, only with the action required by the user.

## **Procedure for the exercise of rights of Users:**

Users may exercise the rights contained in this Policy and those guaranteed by the applicable laws through emails or physical contact addresses previously related.
